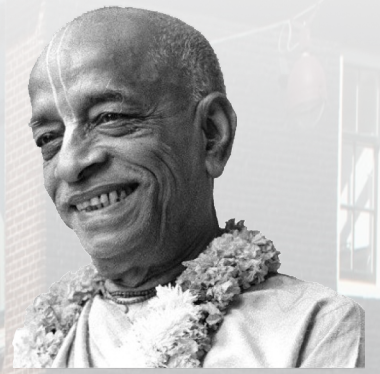

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# HARINAMA AND BOOK DISTRIBUTION (SANKIRTAN)

Harinama, the communal chanting of the Holy Name on the street, is an essential part of Krishna Consciousness. In 2025, devotees of ISKCON Amsterdam took to the streets on several occasions to perform Harinama. Harinama is routinely held during holidays and major holidays, as well as on other special occasions. The reactions from passersby have been overwhelmingly positive. The goal of Harinama is to give as many people as possible the opportunity to hear the Maha Mantra and, where possible, to chant along.



Alongside the chanting, book distribution also takes place during Harinama. At present, a dedicated group of devotees is actively involved in distributing books. In December, traditionally known as the December Marathon, the book table was reintroduced. Devotees went out to various locations in Amsterdam and surrounding areas, such as Almere, to distribute books. In this way, many hundreds of books were handed out. The focus was primarily on *The Path of Perfection*, but other books, such as the *Bhagavad-gita*, were also widely distributed. In addition, countless meaningful conversations were held with interested people.

Devotees from Amsterdam also participate in the national Harinamas organized by HSNL. This enthusiastic group travels throughout the country to spread the Holy Names, sparing no effort in doing so.

At present, there is no follow-up program for people who accept a book or are inspired by the

Harinama. This will be initiated in 2026. There is also a need for professional promotional materials, which will likewise be developed in 2026.

In 2025, it became clear that the participants in Harinama and book distribution demonstrate tremendous enthusiasm and perseverance. However, the group is relatively small compared to the size of the congregation. Therefore, monthly sankirtan festivals will be organized in 2026 to involve a larger portion of the community in book distribution.

Additionally, several inspiration sessions were held in 2025, during which book distributors could speak with one another, with senior distributors, and with other inspiring individuals about their experiences and motivations.

In terms of street outreach, 2025 has been an exceptionally successful year. The challenge for 2026 is to maintain this momentum and further build on this success.



*Many initiatives are planned for 2025 to elevate both the Harinama and book distribution. For example, bimonthly Sankirtan festivals, complete with pizza parties, are being organized (for now). Integration with other activities, such as Food for Life, will be further explored. The idea is to organize an outdoor activity every weekend, so that we, as Hare Krishnas, become more visible to the community and can continue to grow as a congregation.*

# FOOD FOR LIFE

Another public outreach activity is Food for Life. This initiative is globally known for distributing free prasadam meals, and in Amsterdam a group of devotees carries this out every third Saturday of the month. The location near Amstel Station is generally chosen.

The meals are prepared with care and consist of nutritious vegetarian dishes that are first offered and then distributed as prasadam. Food for Life is not only aimed at people who are financially struggling, but is open to anyone who

appreciates a warm meal and a moment of human connection.

Beyond the practical aspect of food relief, the activity also conveys a message of compassion, service, and equality. Volunteers work together in an open and respectful atmosphere, with service to others at the center. Through this monthly activity, Food for Life makes a visible and positive contribution to the city and provides an accessible way to put spiritual values into practice.

# FESTIVALS

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# KINGSDAY

King's Day in Amsterdam is always a colorful and vibrant celebration, but the Maha Harinama adds a unique spiritual dimension each year. While the city transforms into a sea of orange, another color fills the streets: the warm, peaceful energy of the congregational chanting of the Holy Name.

From the moment the devotees gather, a mood of joy and togetherness arises. The mridangas, kartals, and harmoniums set the tone, after which the melodies of the Maha Mantra spread like a gentle wave through the busy streets. # JANMASHTAMI FESTIVAL 2025 – A SPIRITUAL HIGHLIGHT IN THE ORANJEKERK

The 2025 Janmashtami festival, organized by ISKCON Amsterdam in the atmospheric Oranjekerk, was without doubt one of the most impressive and well-attended events of the year. Visitors began arriving early in the evening, and by the time the program was in full swing, thousands had made their way to the church to celebrate the appearance of Lord Krishna. That evening, the Oranjekerk was transformed into a vibrant center of devotion, music, and community.

The book table was also busy throughout the evening, with many interested people taking home books ranging from introductory works on bhakti-yoga to profound philosophical texts such as the *Bhagavad-gita*.

The Janmashtami festival of 2025 was therefore not only a celebration of Krishna's appearance but also a celebration of community, spirituality, and shared joy. The large turnout, the deep dedication of the volunteers, and the warm responses from visitors made it clear that this event plays an important role in the spiritual life of Amsterdam and its surroundings. In total, three thousand plates were given out for free, a beautiful expression of hospitality and compassion, and an essential part of the Ratha Yatra tradition. These artistic details gave the festival a warm and recognizable appearance.

# NEW TEMPLE BUILDING

To carry out our activities more effectively and sustainably, we are actively searching for a new temple building. The current premises have become too small, offer no space for an ashram, and are located in a residential area. As a result, the possibilities are limited: parking is expensive and scarce, and we cannot fully utilize the building in the way we envision.

The search for a new location began several years ago. Our preference is to purchase our own building, allowing us to create a stable and future-proof foundation for our community. We are exploring various options, such as multifunctional spaces in industrial areas or characteristic old churches in Amsterdam and the surrounding region.

We recognize that this is a long-term process. Nevertheless, we continue with determination, trusting that, if Krishna so desires, a suitable location will eventually come our way, a place where our congregation can grow, gather, and spiritually flourish.

Throughout the year, we will keep the community informed of all relevant developments and steps in this process.



# DEITY WORSHIP

Deity worship forms the heart of spiritual life within ISKCON Amsterdam. Every day, Sri Sri Karuna-Nitai Gauracandra are worshipped with care, devotion, and loving attention according to the guidelines given by Srila Prabhupada. This form of worship is not merely a ritual but a living practice that connects the community with the centuries-old Gaudiya Vaishnava tradition.

## *Daily Worship*

The daily program includes multiple arati ceremonies, the offering of freshly prepared meals (bhoga), the singing of holy names, and the recitation of prayers. Volunteers and dedicated pujaris ensure that the Deities are dressed, cared for, and surrounded by an atmosphere of devotion every day. The temple room is cleaned daily so that the Deities are

worshipped in a pure and inspiring environment.

## *Community Involvement*

Deity worship is a collective effort. Members of the congregation contribute by preparing prasadam, arranging flowers, supporting the pujari service, or simply being present during the aratis. This shared devotion strengthens the bonds within the community and creates a spiritual atmosphere in which everyone feels welcome.

## *Festivals and Highlights*

In addition to daily worship, major Vaishnava festivals are celebrated with special attention. On days such as Gaura Purnima, Janmashtami, and Ratha Yatra, extra aratis, kirtans, and special offerings are made. These moments often attract large numbers of visitors

and form highlights in the spiritual year of the community.

### *Pujari Team*

Sri Sri Karuna-Nitai Gauracandra are worshipped and cared for by a dedicated team of pujaris. Over the past year, this team has worked on further professionalizing the pujari services. The pujaris hold weekly meetings in which relevant topics and challenges are discussed.

### *Looking Ahead*

In 2025, ISKCON Amsterdam will continue to deepen and professionalize deity worship. The desire for a larger and more suitable temple building plays an important role in this, so that the worship of Sri Sri Karuna-Nitai Gauracandra can be carried out even better and with more facilities in the future. The community remains enthusiastically committed to realizing this vision.

# FINANCIAL REPORT

## EXPLANATION

The ISKCON Church Society's 2025 financial statements are structured differently than in previous years. Several items have been combined. For example, all donations are now recorded under a single, comprehensive entry. Certain expenditure items have also been combined because, in practice, it proved difficult to break these down consistently and accurately.

In 2025, ISKCON Church Society received approximately €45,000 more in donations than in the previous year. This is related to various campaigns organized throughout the year, including those for festivals.

It is also notable that the building rent entry is lower in 2025 than in 2024. This is because the entry for December 2025 was not made until January 2026. Furthermore, the invoice for January 2025 was received in December 2024 and also recorded in that month.

Finally, ISKCON Amsterdam faced legal costs in 2025. These costs are expected to continue into 2026.

There are no significant developments to report for the ISKCON Trading Foundation. The foundation received very little income in 2025, unlike in 2024, when a catering order was received. However, some expenses were recorded through the ISKCON Trading Foundation.



Below are the income statements of the ISKCON Church Society and the ISKCON Trading Foundation for 2024 and 2025. A budget for 2026 has also been prepared. The balance sheet of the ISKCON Trading Foundation for 2024 and 2025 is also included below.

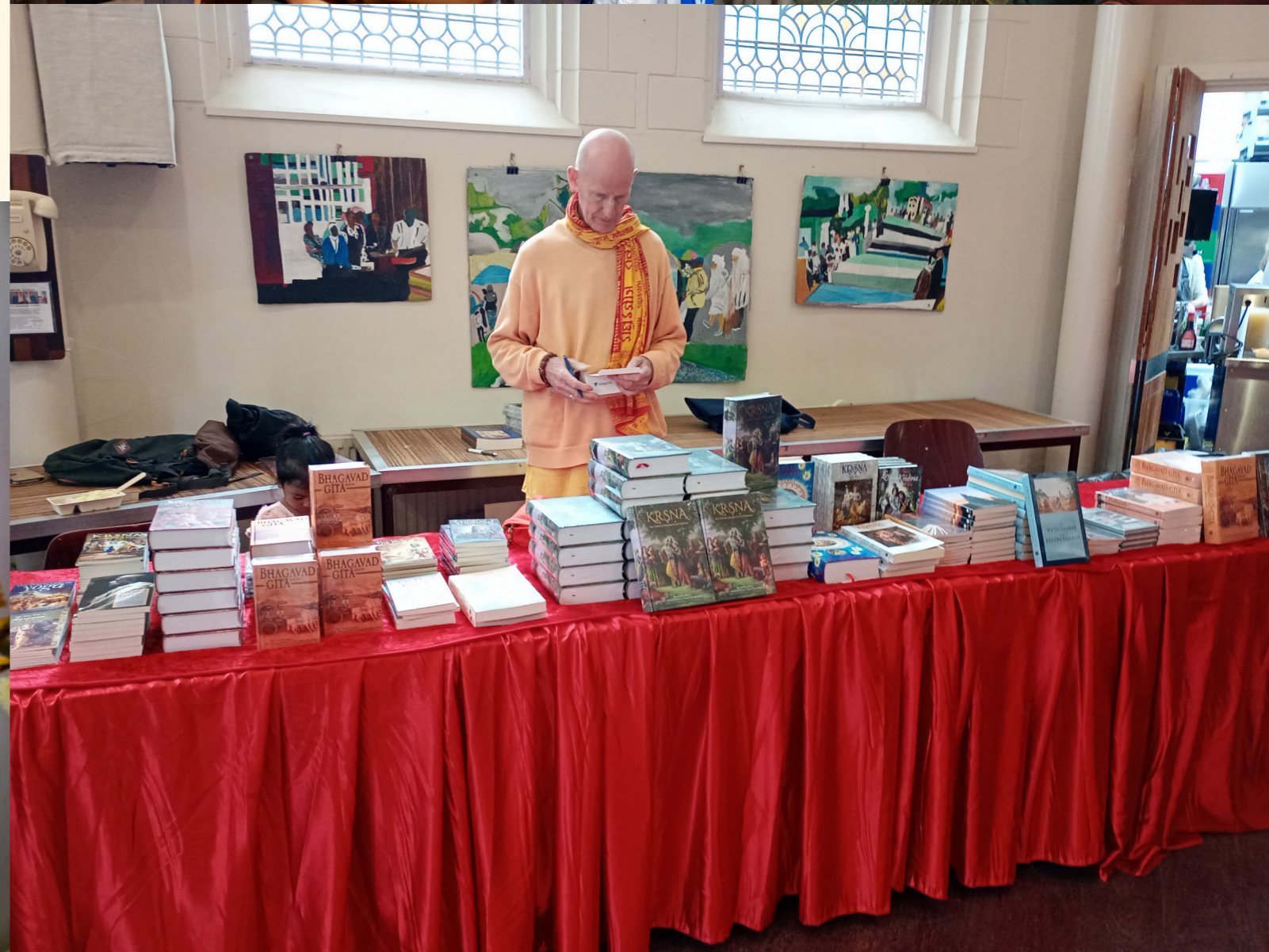
# PREVIEW 2026

The year 2026 will largely be dedicated to the search for a new home for ISKCON Amsterdam. Several interesting and realistic options are currently being considered, although these will still require considerable effort. A new building will enable ISKCON Amsterdam to better achieve its goals and further develop its activities.

Furthermore, we will work on a more consistent and recognizable style in our communications and social media. This will allow us to better inform and support congregation members and visitors.

At the same time, our current activities will continue and, where necessary, further professionalize. In the longer term, we aim to
